Hiking from les Grands Sables to le Palais : Follow the GR340 trail, marked by red and yellow stripes, towards Palais



A network of public transport - Belle-Ile Bus - **serves the main touristic landmarks, most beaches, villages and hamlets.**

Schedules and stops

From September 30 to November 3, a single route criss-crosses the island.

Mid season


Stops and schedules

Three lines operate across the island from April to June and in September.

Peak season

Four lines operate across the island from the beginning of July to the end of August.



PLEASE NOTE: Buses permit small dogs to be transported in baskets or bags (weighing less than 10kg) and do not accommodate bicycles.

Rates

- Single ticket: €3 for adults / €2 for children (ages 4 to 12)
- 10 ticket booklet: €25 for adults and €16 for children (ages 4 to 12)
- Day ticket: €9.50 for adults and €6 for children (ages 4 to 12)


Belle-île by bus (excursion)


The Must-See Tour
